Membership Renewals

When your order has been placed you get an order confirmation, with unique number to quote, which will be copied to you in an e-mail.


If your order gets mucked up during all this, click on Cancel to return to the main Custom Kit page and start again. Select Club wear and then select Northants TOMCC.



For Those Who Ride In France

The names changed on pumps in French petrol stations on 12th October 2018.

The descriptions "lead-free" and "diesel" disappeared, to be replaced by symbols: Circle, square, Rhombus; with the fuel type indicated by letters and numbers. Petrol will be marked by a E surrounded by a circle, associated with a figure reflecting the biofuel content: the unleaded 95 and the unleaded 98 containing maximum 5% ethanol will be replaced by E5, the SP95-E10 will become the E10 and the super ethanol composed 85% of ethanol will be sold under the name E85. For its part, diesel will be reported by B, as biodiesel, surrounded by a square, associated with the numbers 7 or 10 depending on the biofuel content.
